This is an exciting new role and opportunity to join our team based at our studio in the Yorkshire Sculpture Park.

The role will work alongside our core team, in particular our Creative Director Victoria Pratt in supporting both the creation of new physical works and supporting making processes during our artist residency programmes.

We particularly encourage applications from people with backgrounds that are currently under-represented or under-supported within the arts sector and Invisible Flock.

Purpose of the role:

This is an integral freelance addition to our team to support the creative workings and output of our studio. The work will be varied, challenging, with a focus on being rooted at our Yorkshire studio, but with fluidity to also support on a national and international basis depending on the projects underway.

Main duties of role: -

Invisible Flock are looking for a Fabricator and Studio Technician to join the team. The role will work with the company supporting the studio at the Yorkshire Sculpture Park across a spectrum of studio fabricator responsibilities, delivering a spread of projects into production on both a national and international level. The role will work both as part of a team and at times remotely and individually.

The wide variety of projects to be delivered across the time period requires a broad skill set. The role will be best suited for someone who is highly motivated, inventive, flexible and willing to learn and perhaps work outside of your specialism or comfort zone. You will be a fabricator with a wide variety of skills across wood, metal and plastics, comfortable and experienced working with a Laser cutter, a CNC machine and both bench mounted and hand tools.

As a fabricator you will work as part of the creative design team in a role that encompasses prototyping, either using CAD or physical prototypes; developing projects; liaising with external manufacturers, and the maintenance of current works. The role may involve learning new softwares, researching new techniques and methods of production as well as new materials to be implemented in future projects.

As a studio technician you will be responsible for maintenance of equipment and keeping tools in good running order and accessible. You will supervise resident artists and be responsible for all machine and equipment inductions. You will be responsible for ensuring health and safety standards are being met in the studio.

Essential skills and experience: -

Excellent attention to detail with a creative, can do attitude and approach to problem solving

Willingness to work flexible, sometimes unsociable hours when required

Collaborative, with proven ability to work as part of a small team

Locally based, Driving license desired but not essential, happy traveling to our studio in YSP

Willing and able to travel nationally and internationally when required, on occasions driving a van

Ability and desire to work under pressure to deliver high quality work

Interest and enthusiasm for the company's practice
